

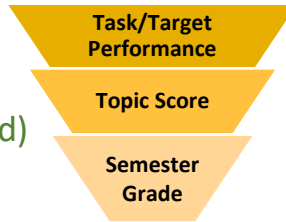


STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT REPORTING GUIDANCE

MEREDITH MIDDLE SCHOOL 2022–2023

Infinite Campus includes information related to student learning progress at three levels:

- Individual **Task** Performance
- Understanding of a **Topic** (standard)
- **Semester Grade**



Each level has a different corresponding scale to make sense of student progress.

Task/Target Performance

Individual Task/Target Performance (assessments, tests, quizzes) align to specific “Learning Targets” within a Topic. Progress is defined using the following values:

ET: Exceeding Target

understanding exceeds grade-level learning

AT: Achieving Target

complete understanding of grade-level learning

PT: Progressing Toward Target

incomplete understanding of grade-level learning

NM: Not Meeting Target

task attempt includes no evidence of grade-level understanding

Topic Score

Topic Scores are a broader representation of understanding, based on consideration of all individual tasks related to the same Topic (standard). Topic scores are not an average of tasks.

Demonstrates proficiency (AT) in all learning targets and success at level 4.	4.0
Demonstrates proficiency (AT) in all learning targets and partial success at level 4.	3.5
Demonstrates proficiency (AT) in all learning targets.	3.0
Demonstrates proficiency (AT) in at least half of learning targets.	2.5
Demonstrates some success criteria (PT) toward all learning targets.	2.0
Demonstrates some success criteria (PT) toward some learning targets.	1.5
Does not meet minimum criteria toward learning targets.	1.0
Produces no evidence appropriate to the learning targets at any level.	0

Semester Grades

At the end of a semester, **Topic Scores** are averaged to create a **Semester Grade** that represents a final description of student capabilities of all Topics (course standards) taught within the semester.

A(Honors) = 3.50 to 4.0

A = 3.0 to 3.49

B = 2.50 to 2.99

C = 2.0 to 2.49

D = 1.75 to 1.99

F = 0 to 1.74

Monitoring Student Progress

Infinite Campus is the digital platform and downloadable app used by Des Moines Public Schools to report student progress. Meredith Middle School sends digital progress reports two times each month.
